If for any reason the ability to draw a classic and symmetric eyebrow is not a talent you currently have, or one that is satisfactorily developed in the opinion of Beauty EverLasting during the pre-class study period, you will have two choices. 1. This will represent the end of the class without the benefit of refund, or 2. You will be required to relinquish eyebrow wor in writing and focus on eyeliner work exclusively.
